"The Plan", which they referred to said pact, was rooted in speaking positively, writing their goals down on a piece paper, and sticking it on their bedroom wall to make it plain; and their willingness to succeed at all cost.



Having been born to two college educated parents, education was paramount in their household, so going off to college was a no-brainer for these two. Yet, finding the resources and mentorships that spoke directly to little black boys and girls, was a huge feat.

The creation of S.C.O.R.E, INC, which stands for Successful, Confident, Optimistic, Regal and Engaging, comes from a place of Christian ministry and an inherent calling on their lives for fellowship and mentorship. It caters to young girls of low to middle income, from all backgrounds, who are rising high school juniors interested in pursuing professions in the fields of medicine and STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics). S.C.O.R.E., INC launched in January 2017 as another layer of "The Plan".

One major focus of our organization is exposing young women to the healthcare field and providing guidance on the rigorous journey of pursuing a career as a healthcare professional. We accomplish this by offering paid, curriculum structured, summer internships held at private or public healthcare facilities. During the 6-8week summer internship we have incorporated a curriculum focused on these 5 life skills: time management, dress for success, test taking preparation, oratorical preparation, life strategic planning, interview skills, college application guidance, and confidence. We feel that these life skills are key components in the journey to success.

Our mentorship program aids in building confident young women who are guided through their journey of becoming a STEM professional. We currently have a data base of exceptional doctors, nurses, and various other STEM professionals who have partnered with S.C.O.R.E, INC and are ready and eager to change the lives of young girls across the world.

Annual Events

S.C.O.R.E, INC Summer Internships

Every summer S.C.O.R.E, INC is offering paid, 6-week summer internships to rising high school juniors who meet the S.C.O.R.E, INC application requirements. The internships are held at a private doctor's or healthcare professionals' office who have partnered with S.C.O.R.E, INC to provide each girl with a specific tailored strategy to gain entrance into a 4-year University and professional health based doctoral programs.

Student Recognition/Award Ceremony

Our annual recognition ceremony is held to highlight the accomplishments of the interns during the 6-week internship. During the ceremony, each intern is required to do an oral presentation on a topic given to them. This ceremony allows them to work on their public speaking skills as well as their overall confidence.



Award College Scholarships

S.C.O.R.E, INC understands that college scholarships provide an opportunity for many people to earn an education. Every year we award a select few of deserving graduating seniors with a college scholarship to help them on their college STEM journey. The awardees are announced every year in June.
